LEVELS OF GIVING

We have provided the following giving levels to recognize contributions made by either you or your firm.

\$1,000 Society of Justice

Should you or your firm contribute \$1,000 in the course of a year, you will be recognized in the Society of Justice in our annual report and other Foundation publications.

\$500 - \$999 Rutledge Patron

This level honors the state's first Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, John Rutledge.

\$250 - \$499 Wright Patron

This level honors South Carolina's first African-American attorney and the nation's first African-American appellate judge, Jonathan Jasper Wright.

\$100 - \$249 JM Perry Patron

This level honors the first woman admitted to the practice of law in the state, Miss James M. Perry.
